These new loudspeakers are actually a set of "acoustic building blocks" for assembling a system perfectly suited to any room and budget, but one that still maintains a consistent tonal balance. This insures that any mix of different 1400/2400 speakers will always sound "right." As sound travels around the room from one speaker to another, the tonal transition is seamless, maintaining perfect sonic believability.

The key to the extraordinary sound of these new systems is the advanced design of their drivers. Their woofers are long-throw, high power-handling designs. The tweeter in the LR and C speakers is Atlantic's exclusive Low Resonance Tweeter (LRT™). This amazing tweeter crosses over an octave lower than conventional tweeters, delivering far wider midrange dispersion for a much more 'open,' unboxy, lifelike sound. This broad dispersion also maximizes speaker placement and listener seating flexibility.

1400 LR and 2400 LR Front Channel Speakers

The 2400 LR speakers are high performance two-way systems intended to be mated with a quality subwoofer, such as Atlantic's own 224 SB, 334 SB or 444 SB. Each speaker houses two 4½ inch GLH (Graphite Loaded Homopolymer) mid-woofers and our sophisticated 1-inch LRT soft dome tweeter

The 1400 LR satellites utilize use a single GLH driver and the same 1-inch LRT tweeter.

Designed for smaller spaces such as dens or bedrooms, these speakers are ideal for applications where cost and size are a consideration.

1400 C and 2400 C Center Channel Speakers

These speakers employ closely-grouped M-T-M driver arrays for optimum coverage of the listening area. In addition, as with all of our center channel speakers, they come with a unique tilting base so the speaker is always precisely aimed at your ears. This aiming capability ensures high intelligibility of voices, dialogue, and onscreen effects.

High Frequency Tweeter Level Switch - The 1400 C and 2400 C have a three-position switch to compensate for 'live' or 'dead' room acoustics so the sound is never too bright or too dull.

Boundary Compensation - Placing a center channel speaker directly on a large-screen TV or in a bookshelf unit can cause a buildup of lower midrange energy that makes voices and instruments sound unnaturally thick and heavy.

To compensate, we've developed a boundary circuit that counteracts this problem. When activated, the boundary compensation switch will return the lower midrange—particularly male voices—to its natural, uncolored state.

1400 SR-z and 2400 SR Surround Speakers

A single pair of 1400 SR's or 2400 SR's can replicate the sound of the large array of surround speakers found in the best commercial movie theaters.

Set for "Dipole," they create a diffuse soundfield that is virtually impossible to pinpoint by ear, enveloping the listening room in realistic three-dimensional sound effects.

Set to "Bipole," they deliver a more precisely localizable sound pattern that can be very dramatic with high-impact popular music. The listener can choose the preferred effect with the flick of a switch. The 1400 SR-z's small size makes it particularly appropriate for use as 'height' speakers in the very newest home theater systems.
